## Outline of Hokkaido University International Houses 2019.10~

The International House was established for international students in order to give a comfortable life during their studies at Hokkaido University.

1. Brief description of each dormitory

## <Keiteki-Ryo>

Accommodation: 40 rooms for male students (About 12 m²) Established in 1983

Expenses: Rent - \(\frac{1}{2}\)4,700 per month

Utilities charges – Around ¥5,000~¥7,000 per month

Common space: Shower rooms, lounges with kitchen, washstand/laundry rooms, lavatories

Equipment in each room: Bed, desk, chair, bookshelf, locker, desk lamp, refrigerator, panel heater, hanger shelf, trash box, curtains.

Note: Japanese students also live in this dormitory. Internet is available (Residents have to contract and pay for the Internet by themselves).

#### 2. Application of occupancy

In principle, selection of residents is made biannually in January and July by the Student Support Division, Academic Affairs Department through the *Kyomu-Tanto* (Academic Affairs Section) at each faculty. In addition, if there are vacant rooms, you can apply through the *Kyomu-Tanto* at any time.

#### 3. Other

- Except for Keiteki-Ryo and Sosei-Ryo, lodging expenses and service charge must be paid at convenience stores. (Commission is charged when residents pay in convenience stores.)
- •The allocation of rooms is determined by the University. You cannot change rooms or dormitories.
- ·As each residence has kitchens, residents can cook their own meals.
- There is no parking area for residents in the dormitories. Personal parking in or around the

dormitory may be evicted.

- ·If residents delay in their rent for more than 2 months, they may be evicted.
- ·Residents are responsible for paying a fee for the lost of their keys, or damaging of equipment.
- •Residents of any dormitory can borrow bedlinens. Hokkaido University International House and Sapporo International Student Center residents must pay cleaning charge for bedlinens through the Hokudai COOP. Keiteki-Ryo and Sosei-Ryo residents must pay about ¥4,000 when they vacate. Please consult when you move in.
- ·Residents of Keiteki-Ryo and Sosei-Ryo are responsible for cleaning up their own rooms and for disposing their personal belongings when they leave dormitory.
- •Residents of Hokkaido University International Student Houses are required to pay cleaning fee before vacating. The amount billed will depend on dormitories. Sapporo International Student Center does not charge room cleaning fee if the room is left in a good condition.
- ·Residents are required to observe the rules and regulations of their residences. Residents who cause serious trouble may be their residency status revoked.
- ·All dormitories have Internet service. (Also confirm "1. Brief description of each house" about fee.)
- ·All residents living in Hokkaido University International House or Sapporo International Student Center (excluding keiteki-ryo and sosei-ryo) are required to pay ¥50,000 as a deposit at the time of the first payment, for the final payment and the repair cost of the room in case the repair of the room is needed. (If you don't have any payment unpaid and repair point of your room, when you leave the dormitory, you can get a refund(full amount).)
- · About Hokkaido University International House and Sapporo International Student Center, if the part of the room is damaged because of the resident, the resident may have to compensate for that fee.
  - \*About Hokkaido University International House Fushimi and Kita 8 building 2 and 4 for singles, if the part of the common space of the room is damaged apparently by the specified resident, the specified resident may have to compensate for that fee and if the resident can't be specified, the residents in the same unit may have to compensate for that fee fairly.
