Brush-Up English Program Descriptions

CEED Support Program

July, 2015

Objectives

This program aims to help graduate students and sophomore, junior, senior improve their basic English communication skills. It also encourages them to actively participate in various courses, such as the International Relations Program, using the English skills they have developed. In the program, instructors from external training institutions provide lessons on campus.

Program details

The program offers the following English course where teachers from external training institutions provide small-group classes.

CEED covers some of the tuition. The amount of the tuition is shown as below.

①Speaking and Writing (Instructor: Mr. Stephen Burrow)

The tuition fee to be paid by students is 10,000yen (plus textbook approximately 6000 yen)

A class consists of 6-20 students.

The maximum number of students per class will be 20.

The class will be conducted in English.

Students are to bring a note PC.

Using a TOEFL practice textbook, students are to:

learn basic ideas about TOEFL-iBT and its structure and strategy for the test.

practice repeatedly for the test especially on the Speaking and Writing sections.

take tests on the first day and the last day and be evaluated.

②Summer Intensive English Camp (training institution: Orange Bird)

The fee to be paid by students is 18,000yen (for meals, accommodation, and textbook)

The tuition and other miscellaneous cost will be paid by CEED.

The maximum number of students per class will be nine. We may cancel the camp if the number of application is below six.

Prerequisites

①Speaking and Writing

- 1. The program is open to graduate students, sophomore, junior, senior enrolled in students enrolled in Graduate School of Engineering, Graduate School of Information Science and Technology and Graduate School of Chemical Sciences and Engineering (students taught by instructors of the Faculty of Engineering) and School of Engineering.
- 2. Students should avoid tardiness and absence, finish all assignments and prepare/review lessons.
- 3. Students who have taken a TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS or a Test in Practical English Proficiency (Eiken) within the last two years are requested to submit a score or a certificate to CEED.
- 4. Students enrolled in the program are asked to apply for and participate in an internship program.

2Summer Intensive English Camp

- 1. The program is open to graduate students, sophomore, junior, senior enrolled in students enrolled in Graduate School of Engineering, Graduate School of Information Science and Technology and Graduate School of Chemical Sciences and Engineering (students taught by instructors of the Faculty of Engineering) and School of Engineering.
- 2. Students should avoid tardiness and absence, finish all assignments and prepare/review lessons. Students should well prepare for the camp.
- 3. Students are expected to speak in English during the camp.
- 4. Students enrolled in the program are asked to apply for and participate in an internship program.

Class period and times

①Speaking and Writing

Class meets from 9am to 1pm everyday from August 5 to 11.

2Summer Intensive English Camp

Attendants leave Hokudai on September 24 and come back from Otaki Seminar House on 28.

Applicants must submit application/agreement form for program registration and pay the fee in person at CEED Office by July 24(Fri.) at noon. (Applications by e-mail will not be accepted.) Form can be downloaded from CEED Website or obtained at CEED Office.
